Sagamore Line Reinforcement Project, Western Segment Phases I & II Sandwich, Massachusetts

March 30, 2015

Dear Neighbors,

Colonial Gas Company d/b/a National Grid will soon begin the construction of the Sagamore Line Reinforcement Project, Western Segment Phases I and II. The following is key project and construction information.

About the Project: National Grid will install a 20-inch gas transmission main for over 4.4 miles on the north side of Service Road in Sandwich between Route 130 and Chase Road. Phase I will go from Route 130, east to Quaker Meeting House Road, and Phase II will go from Quaker Meeting House Rd, east to Chase Road – see the enclosed maps. The purpose of this project is to maintain reliability and meet the growing demand for natural gas on Cape Cod. The project has been reviewed and approved by the Energy Facilities Siting Board and the Cape Cod Commission and has received necessary permits from the Town of Sandwich.

Construction: Construction of the project will start around the Spring of 2015 and will be completed the following year. As a local neighbor, you will see our construction crews and vehicles traveling through the area. The work will progress along the routes listed with crews located in a given area anywhere from a few days to a few weeks at a time.

Your Opportunity to Request Visual Mitigation: National Grid is committed to providing visual mitigation per our visual mitigation program and supplemental plan that were presented to the community. Included with this letter is a form to indicate your interest in initiating the visual mitigation process. Upon receiving a completed form, we will contact abutters to determine eligibility and begin the process. Visual mitigation will occur in phases as construction advances on the project. Please contact me if you would like copies of the original program and/or supplemental plan or if you have any questions.

National Grid will continue to provide notifications or other key information as the project progresses. In the meantime, please feel free to contact me with any questions or for further information. Thank you.
